For 17 years, DesignX has stood as a beacon of creativity and innovation on the peninsula, bringing together budding designers and makers from Los Altos and beyond.

Its founder, Durga K, has a background in textile and fashion design, from childhood visiting her grandfather's textile mill and in her professional life as a garment designer.

After moving to Silicon Valley, she noticed a lack of opportunities to expose her children to these more tactile fields of design. There was an emphasis on digital experiences and technology, but she knew first-hand how much children can grow from the hands-on creativity that clothing, architecture, and physical products bring.

She co-founded DezinKidz in 2009, and after growing that from modest beginnings, she founded DesignX in 2017 with the vision of being the destination for young creators. She wants to inspire the tinkerers, and provide a foundation for kids to learn about fashion, apparel, toys, and architectural design.

At DesignX, the motto is “Dream it. Design it. Make it.” With an emphasis on upcycling and sustainability, this is a supportive network of creatives and innovators. They believe that every child is unique and so is their design. In fact, that is what inspired the name DesignX. Each child has a certain X-factor that can’t be quantified.

The company offers summer programs, year-round seminars, and school partnerships for children grades 2-12. The courses are taught by a mix of industry professionals and up-and-coming talent from top universities across the US. The programs fall under a few categories, and the subjects mirror what you’d find at design schools like Parsons or Pratt: fashion design, toy design, architecture, product design, fashion illustration, upcycling, textile design, and accessory design. However, these courses are designed with kids in mind.

By focusing on products for the physical world, students draw inspiration from both natural and constructed environments. They develop an appreciation for aesthetics and craftsmanship. Sustainability is another cornerstone, as students reimagine these industries and learn thoughtful, ethical practices in making and constructing. DesignX helps fashionistas build confidence by giving them a space and tools to bring their visions to life.

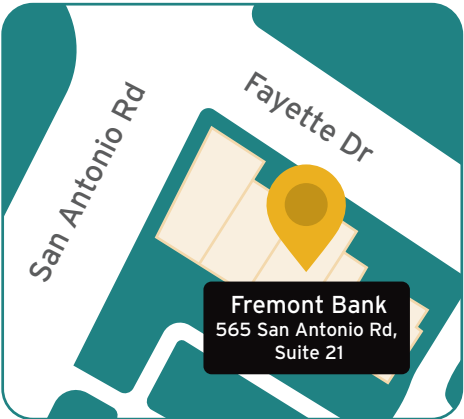
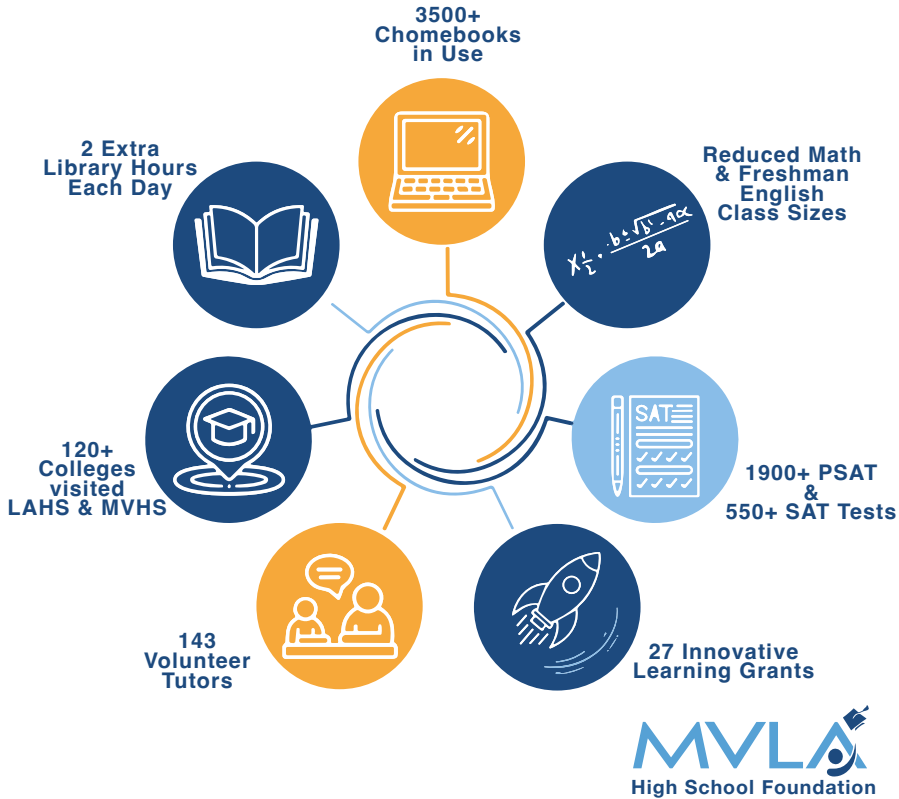

MURAL MURAL on the wall



Our public art installations provide joy and delight throughout our community. The communal art program, managed by local nonprofit Arts Los Altos, captures the values of our community, inspires creativity and helps us express pride. With each brushstroke, these murals tell stories, spark conversations, and bring residents together. They create a shared cultural tapestry reflecting the heart of our town.

Nestled along the 3rd Street wall of Chase Bank lies a mural that truly celebrates our community. “Welcome to Redwood Grove,” by Jorge Juarez from Koichi Arts, was painted in part by residents and visitors of the 2024 Los Altos Art & Wine Festival. Making the piece ever more meaningful, the subject celebrates our local park, Redwood Grove.

“Be the Change,” by Cameron Moberg, features native California flowers and butterflies. The vibrant colors and stunning scale of the piece can be seen from blocks away.

Downtown cafe and shop, Tal Palo, commissioned artist Rocca Luis César from Mexico to design the modern and lively mural, “La Cosecha” (The Harvest). Local muralist, Nigel Sussman, painted the piece, bringing it to life in Tal Palo’s patio. “La Cosecha,” which celebrates family and abundance, can also be seen from San Antonio in the parking area behind the cafe.

Just a short walk away, “Historical Mosaic,” designed by the talented duo of Susan W. and Rafael M., takes visitors on a journey through Los Altos’ rich history. This mural features iconic local landmarks, from the original downtown buildings to the sprawling hills that surround the city. The artists cleverly weave together the past and present, reminding residents of their roots while inspiring them to envision a bright future.

“Grateful Harvest,” by Francisco Ramirez, beams from the wall of local produce market DeMartini’s Orchard. As residents and visitors shop, they are reminded of the extraordinary effort needed to bring food to our table.

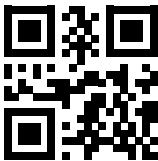

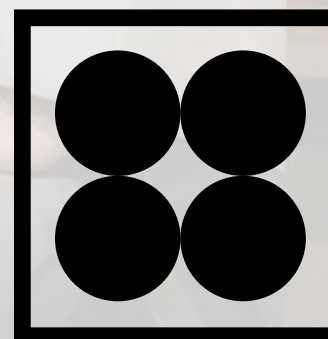

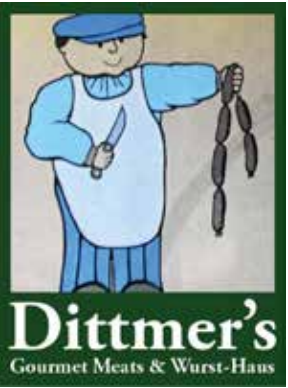
